## ***Animal Art***

Students will create a variety of artwork based on the animal kingdom. They will learn to draw animals including fish, mammals and insects and be introduced to various art materials such as paint, coloured pencils, clay, pastels, charcoal & ink. These materials will be used for specialized art making techniques such as painting, printmaking and origami.

## ***Arts Alive***

*An exploration of artistic materials!*  
The projects will not be themed, so students can create artwork based on their own interests and creative explorations. Students will be encouraged to use multiple mediums in a single artwork and to be expressive in their use of colour and materials. Students will be exposed to famous artworks and will learn a new art based vocabulary.

## ***Figure Fun***

Students will create an assortment of artworks using the human body as inspiration. They will learn how to draw the human body proportionately, as well as in motion using a variety of artistic materials including graphite, coloured pencil, pastels, charcoal, ink, water colour and more.

## ***Culture Crafts***

Students will create artworks inspired by cultures from all over the world. An assortment of 2 and 3 dimensional media as well as alternative art materials will be used. They will learn to interpret a wide range of international cultures and mythologies, through the eyes of an artist.
